The following spay/neuter programs are available to assist in paying for the cost of Spay/Neuter Surgeries. **Income and Residency restrictions apply.**

The Maryland Department of Agriculture: Free Spay/Neuter for Dogs and Cats.

This program has been funded by a grant from the Maryland Department of Agriculture to offer Free Spay/Neuter and Rabies Vaccines for pets of low income families living within the towns of Waldorf, Brandywine, White Plains, LaPlata and Indian Head. To qualify, you must live within the 20601, 20602, 20603, 20607, 20611, 20613, 20616, 20640, 20646, 20658, 20662, 20675 or 20695 zip and be able to provide proof of annual household income less than \$75,000. These surgeries must be performed at the Humane Society of Charles County. You must receive a voucher prior to scheduling surgery. **Program Funding is Limited.**

The Snyder Foundation for Animals: Spay/Neuter Project
