1. Location, Date & Time: The 2017 Holiday Craft Fair will once again be held at Thomas Stone High School, 3785 Leonardtown Road, Waldorf, MD on December 3, 2017, and will be open to the public from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm.

2. Crafter Space Information:

Each space is 8 feet long and approximately 6 feet deep. Spaces are assigned on a "first come, first served" basis. Special space requests will be honored as much as possible but **are not guaranteed. We are unable to provide tables or chairs this year. You will receive a confirmation by email from us once your application is approved.** Crafters are responsible for their own tables, chairs, electrical cords & Wi-fi. Crafters are not permitted to nail, tack, or staple to the school's walls. As of November 1, Cafeteria spaces sold out.

3. Goods Being Sold: The Humane Society has always supported crafters who "hand craft" their items. Commercially made items are not permitted.

4. New: We are asking that all crafters consider donating an item representative of their wares to be used as raffle prizes to benefit the Humane Society. We will give recognition for each donation and help direct interested shoppers to your table. A "win/win" scenario for all involved – crafter, shopper, and the Humane Society!

5. Crafter Check In: Crafters may start check in at 8:00 am and will be directed to their space. You will be directed to unload your items at the closest door to your location. After unloading your items, **your vehicle MUST be moved to the crafter parking areas at the sides of the school, this will be enforced.**

6. Crafter Parking: **There will be absolutely no crafter parking in front of the school.** This space is reserved for your paying customers! All vehicles must be parked in the east or west parking areas **this will be strictly enforced.**

7. Crafter Take Down: All crafters, items, and displays must be out of the building by 4:30 pm the day of the craft fair.

Please note that the Humane Society will hold a White Elephant sale & will be selling HSCC related items during the craft fair. We will also have animal related basket items for sale. There will be food vendors in the parking lot in front of the school. Neither the HSCC nor Thomas Stone High School is responsible for any theft, breakage, or loss of items.
