The Kennel Manager is responsible for the efficient running and overall success of all aspects of the kennel. This position oversees the work quality and productivity of shelter staff as part of the team and leads by example. Ensures staff is informed of events and promotions and supports those goals. Provides excellent customer service to all clients, prioritizes solutions, and is a proactive and creative problem-solver. Provides leadership and training direction to the team; fosters a positive, team-oriented work environment; and is focused on the advancement of the welfare of the animals in our care and their placement into appropriate forever homes. Kennel Manager is responsible for recruiting, training and mentoring a productive volunteer team to support and assist the paid staff in the execution of daily kennel operations. The Kennel Manager is responsible to ensure all facility and grounds are in good working order and maintained. The Kennel Manager ensures that the operations of the kennel and staff meet HSCC's mission and Standards of Care.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

Be dedicated to the mission of HSCC and the welfare of animals, and:

- Work weekends, evenings, and holidays
- Respond after hours with 30 minutes
- Speak, read, and write in English
- Carry out oral and written instructions
- Proficient in MS Office and social media
- Possess positive attitude
- Perform duties under stress
- Be self-motivated
